#### 1.0 **INTRODUCTION**

HPCL Visakh Refinery's Continuous Catalytic Reformer (CCR) unit and Naphtha Isomerization Unit (NIU) produces high Octane blend streams for production of Motor Spirit (MS) by conversion of a straight run naphtha. CCR and NIU involve chemical reactions that take place within the reactor loaded with active catalyst. #### **Conversion Factor:**

For Purchase Orders / Completion Certificates in foreign currencies, the respective values will be converted to INR w.r.t. annual average exchange rate of the Indian Financial Year in which the Purchase Order / Completion Certificate was issued. requirement of PQC or written letter from Owner specifying the nature of work with quantities and values can be submitted for qualification.

g. Bidder are required to submit all such past experience (s) meeting the PQC along with relevant supporting documents in the first instance itself, along with the bid. Accordingly, only such past experience(s) shall be considered for qualification, details of which are provided in the bid by the bidder in Form-X of proposal forms and subsequently no additional past experience shall be sought from the Bidder. #### 5.4 ELIGIBILITY OF BIDDERS

- 5.4.1 All bidders shall be required to provide a declaration stating that they have not been suspended or banned or delisted by any government or quasi government agencies or Indian PSUs or GeM. If a bidder has been suspended or banned by any government or quasi government agencies or PSUs or GeM, this fact must be clearly stated and it may not necessarily be a cause of disqualification. If declaration is not given, the bid shall be rejected as non responsive.
- 5.4.2 Bidder should not be under liquidation, court receivership or similar proceedings. Bidder shall submit self-declaration in this regard.
- 5.4.3 Parties who are affiliates of one another can decide which affiliate will make a bid. Only one affiliate may submit a bid. Two or more affiliates are not permitted to make separate bids directly or indirectly. If 2 or more affiliates submit a bid, then any one or all of them are liable for disqualification.
  - "Affiliate" of a Party shall mean any company or legal entity which:
  - (a) controls either directly or indirectly a Party, or
  - (b) which is controlled directly or indirectly by a Party; or
  - (c) is directly or indirectly controlled by a company, legal entity or partnership which directly or indirectly controls a Party. - 5.4.4 Bids may be submitted by:
  - a) Sole bidder: a single person (Sole Proprietorship) or entity;
  - b) A newly formed incorporated joint venture (JV) which has not completed 3 financial years from the date of commencement of business;

- 5.4.5 Fulfilment of Eligibility criteria and certain additional conditions in respect of each of the above types of bidders are stated below:
- a) The bidder (including an incorporated JV which has completed 3 financial years after date of commencement of business) shall fulfil each qualification criteria (PQC).
